



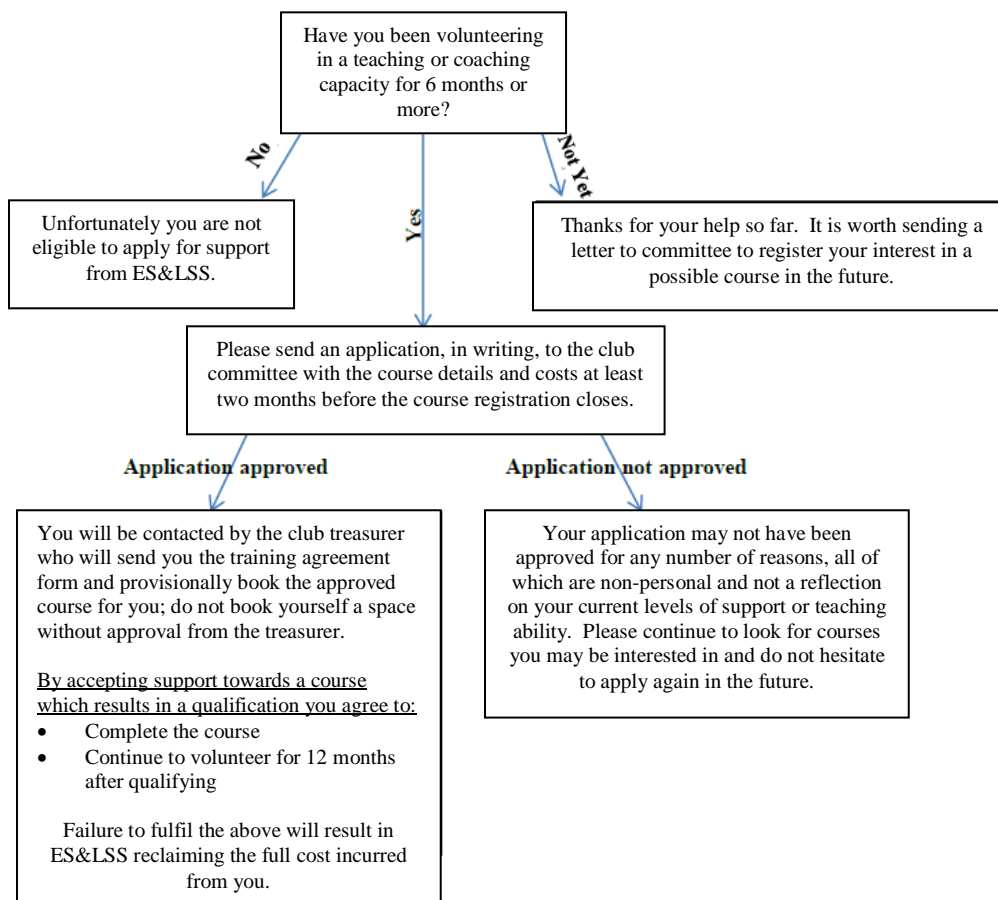
**Exmouth Swimming and Life Saving Society funding commitment statement.**

Exmouth Swimming and Life Saving Society (ES&LSS) are committed to providing support for club volunteers. Volunteers have the opportunity to access a wide range of professional development opportunities, in recognition of the hard work they provide.

ES&LSS will consider all applications for support, including financial, experience provision, and mentoring.

All applications for support will be considered on an individual basis by the club's committee, against set criteria. As with all voluntary clubs and initiatives, funds for financial support are not limitless and in this respect only a certain number of support applications will be considered per year.

Use the flow chart below to see if you are eligible for support from ES&LSS.



To secure funding for a course at level 2 or above candidates must also meet the following additional criteria. The applicant must; be nominated by a sub-committee, be aged over 21 years, and have held any prior qualification for a period of at least 12 months before applying for funding.

Part funding shall be given if the applicant uses the qualification for work or with any other organisation. Full funding may be given to any applicant who intends to use the qualification solely as a volunteer of the club.
